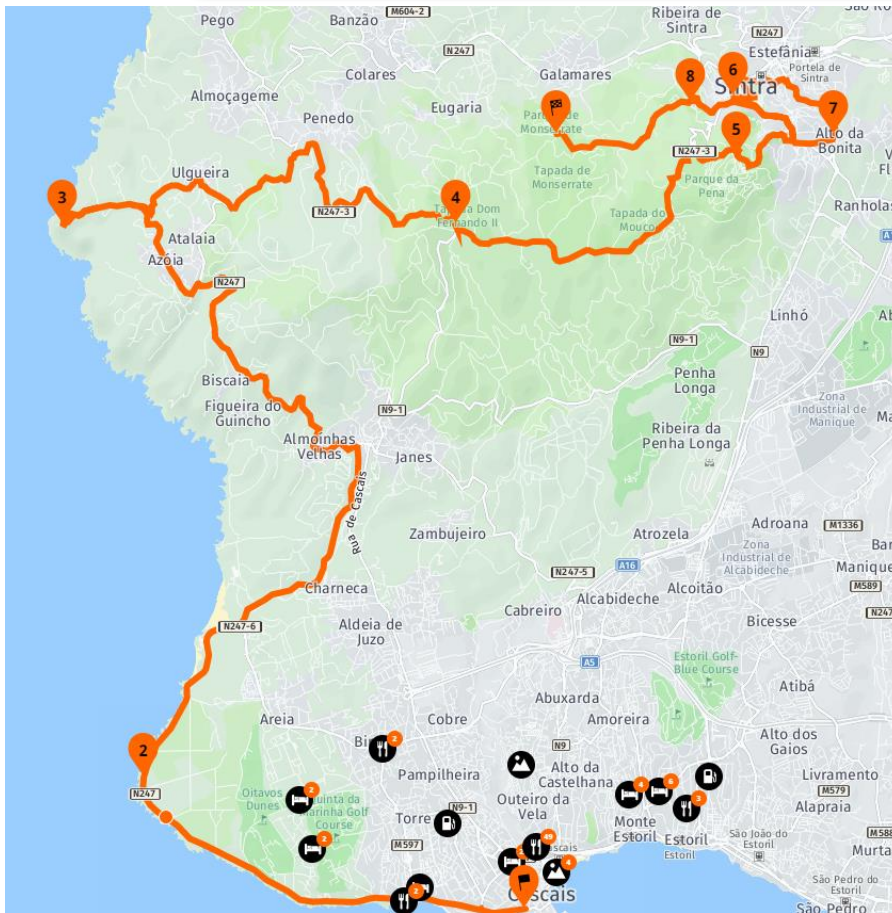




## 28<sup>th</sup> European HOG Rally – Cascais – Portugal

Lisboa Chapter: Self-Guided – “The Mountain”

Time: 1h30m Distance: around 60km



The Sintra Mountain and his charm, 60km of Sea and Forest Roads.

This tour will lead you to the most western Point of the European Continent(6) and also to some cultural places inside the mountain.

We planned this route to go around Sintra Mountain and Sintra Center.

Due to some recent changes in the traffic in Sintra is become impossible to have a tool to draw a correct route around Sintra.

So we present you the stops that you can go and you plan your route accordingly.

The map on the left is a possible and probably best way to see all the places.

Be aware of the Sintra Mountain they are narrow, drive carefully, use your HORN to show your presence.

Point 1 (Starting Point) is Hipodromo at the top roundabout near the 28<sup>th</sup> European H.O.G. Rally

Point 2 ( Road near the Ocean) is the most scenic road, if you skip this waypoint, GPS will draw a more direct line but with no interest at all

Point 3 (Cabo da Roca) the most western Point of Europe, you can buy a diploma there with your name.

Point 4 (Capuchos Monastery) A very very old monastery of “Franciscan friar”. It’s a very humble place with no great painter or sculptures. In there you can see how was their humble life.

Point 5 (Pena Palace) Completely different from Capuchos, there you see a Palace. You have to park your Harley and climb to the Palace.

Point 6 (Sintra Center) A must see city center, try to park you Harley and walk

Point 7 (ramalhao) It’s just a POINT to force the route to the next destination

Point 8(Regaleira palace) A must see Palace, you can walk from the city center.

Point 9 (Monserrate Palace) You have to park your Harley and walk to the Palace.

Sintra Center as just changed completely their roads, we didn't find a route planner with the new directions.

From Sintra Center to Monserrate you have to go to Ramalhão, return the same road and continue to Regaleira and Monserrate

The mountain Roads are narrow so drive carefully.

At any stage you can point the GPS to Point 1 and will draw a route to Cascais Center
