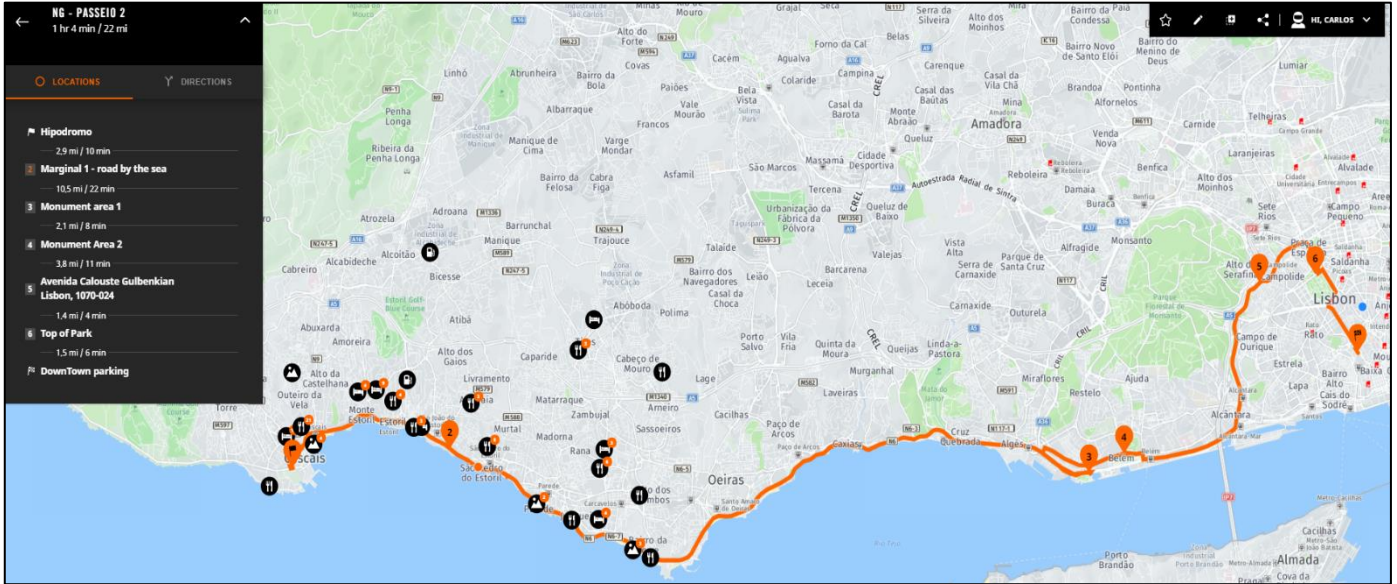




# 28<sup>th</sup> European HOG Rally – Cascais – Portugal

## Lisboa Chapter: Self-Guided– “Lisbon Monuments”

Distance: 68km



This a tour that will guide you through some of the Lisbon Monuments.

You are going to pass thru them and you can stop whatever you want.

Exit Cascais and go to Lisbon by the sea road.

The Monument area is divided in two, mainly because you have a railroad between them. You can choose to park your Harley around Monument area 1 and walk around, you can cross to the other side by a walk under the railroad in front of “Padrao dos descobrimentos”

- 9- Electricity Museum

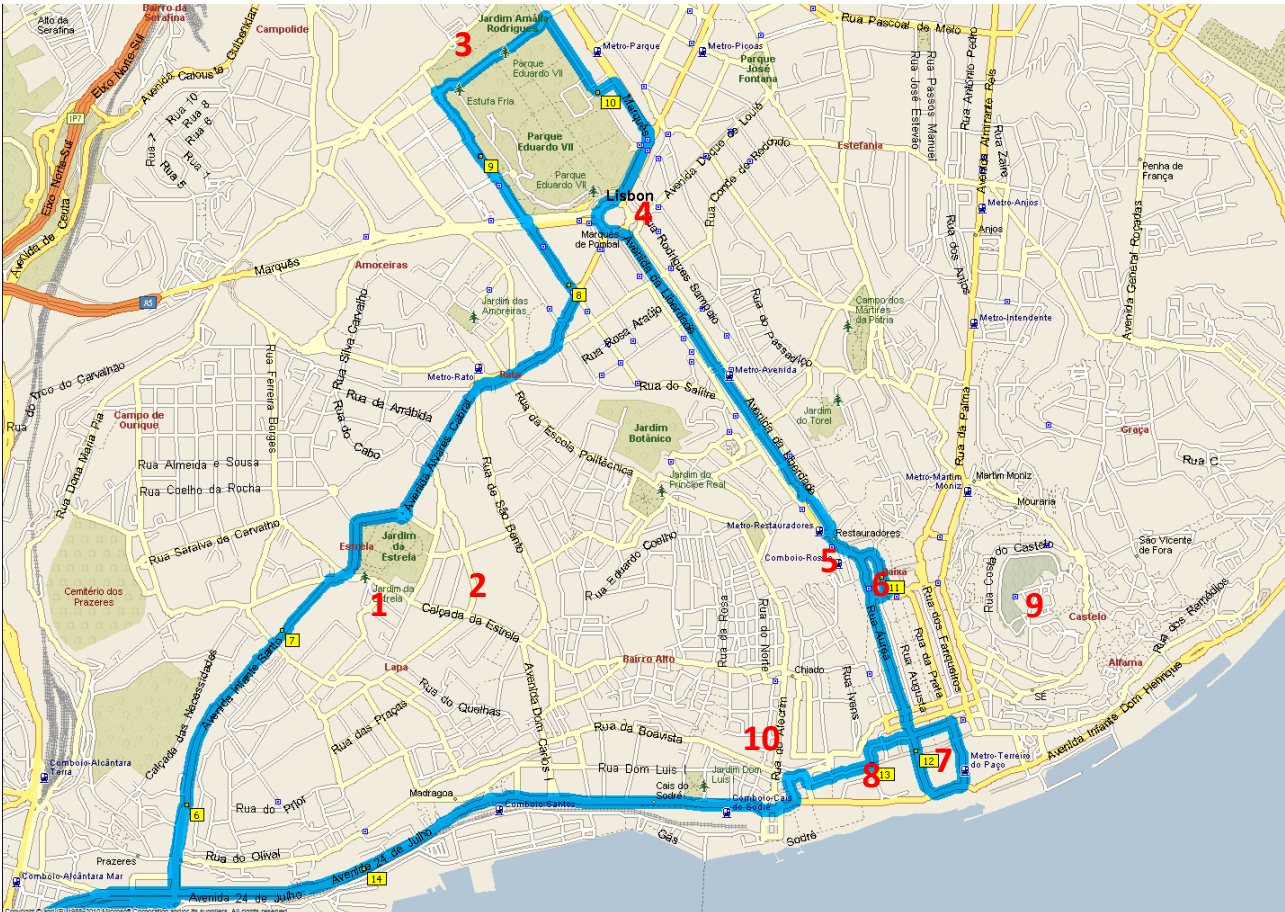

We made waypoints that you can go or avoid. Understand that you can take a full day to visit the Monuments and another day to visit downtown Lisbon.

Downtown Lisbon is difficult to park, so the endroute is near the entrance of the main parking in downtown.

13<sup>th</sup> of June is Holiday in Lisbon, the party starts on the night of 12<sup>th</sup>, don't come with your Harley to city center because it's CLOSED to traffic, WALK !!! You can walk around points 5 to 10.

Lisbon roads have rails from electric trams. Be carefull. Don't go to the castle with your Harley unless you are a **VERY VERY EXPERIENCED RIDER**, go by foot !
